

Northeastern University Contingency Plan Summary Sheet

This plan serves as emergency response guidelines in the event there is a major spill or other catastrophic event related to hazardous waste or hazardous materials on Northeastern Campus. The complete plan is currently stored within the Office of Environmental Compliance & Occupational Safety (ECOS). This document serves as a quick reference guide for emergency response.

REASONS TO IMPLEMENT THE CONTINGENCY PLAN:

- If a spill is corrosive, flammable, reactive or toxic
- If a spill exceeds the reporting quantity as defined by the state of Massachusetts
- If a spill or other catastrophic event related to hazardous waste or hazardous materials poses a threat to human health of the environment
- Fire, smoke, or other life-threatening conditions are present

Locations of Emergency Response Equipment

- Fire extinguishers are located in all laboratories and mechanical rooms where hazardous materials are stored
- Spill supplies are maintained for laboratory scale spill sin hallways of each research facility, and for oil spills throughout campus in clearly marked spill kits
- Fire alarms are located in hallways, utility and mechanical rooms throughout campus
